HOST HOME (hōst hōm) *n.* 1 one who welcomes guests into one's fixed place of abode.

FACILITATOR (fə·sil'ə·tā·tər) *n.* 1 one who looks at the material prior to the group meeting and asks questions at a venue. 2 does not have to answer questions. 3 Commits to listening to the weekly messages and attending the 6 week small group study.

GROUP MEMBER (grōp mem·'bər) *n.* 1 A number of persons, brought together; as an assemblage; cluster. 2 Purchases study guide for series cost is \$12.00. 3 Answers questions asked by the facilitator. 4 Commits to listening to the weekly messages and attending the 6 week small group study.
